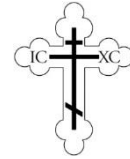

Troparion – Tone 2 (Resurrection)

When Thou didst descend to death, O Life Immortal, /
 Thou didst slay hell with the splendor of Thy Godhead! /
 And when from the depths Thou didst raise the dead, /
 All the powers of heaven cried out: ///
 O Giver of Life! Christ our God! Glory to Thee!

Troparion – Tone 2 (Noble Joseph)

The noble Joseph, /
 When he had taken down Thy most pure Body from the tree, /
Wrapped it in fine linen and anointed it with spices, /
 And placed it in a new tomb. /
 But Thou didst rise on the third day, O Lord, ///
 Granting the world great mercy.

Troparion – Tone 2 (Saint)

O beloved Apostle of Christ God, /
 Make haste to deliver thy defenseless people, /
 For He shall receive thee falling in prayer before Him /
 As He hast received thee falling upon His breast. /
 Ask Him, O divine theologian, that the nations emerge from darkness, ///
 And to grant our souls peace and great mercy.

Kontakion - Tone 2 (Saint)

Who shall declare thy greatness, O virgin apostle? /
 For thou dost gush forth miracles /
 And art a fount of healing /
 Who dost intercede for our souls, ///
 As theologian and friend of Christ.

Kontakion - Tone 2 (Myrrhbearing Women)

Thou didst command the myrrhbearers to rejoice, O Christ! /
 By Thy Resurrection, Thou didst stop the lamentation of Eye, O God! /
 Thou didst command Thine apostles to preach: //
 The Savior is risen!
